James R. Ferguson has completed thirty-five years of federal service including four years with the United States Army during 1942-1946 and ten years with the United States Labor Department from 1965 to 1975 as Veterans Employment Representative from Massachusetts, and

Jim Ferguson's dedication to the cause of veterans employment resulted in his being chosen as a member of the Governors Commission on Employment of the Handicapped for Disabled Veterans, the Jobs for Veterans Task Force, as a member of the Advisory Board of the Veterans Education Training Program of the University of Massachusetts, and his selection as Veterans Representative for the Veterans Administration Hospitals and the Massachusetts Division of Employment Security, and

James R. Ferguson has been the recipient of numerous citations by veterans organizations for his efforts in Job Development and was cited for by the Presidents Committee on Jobs for Veterans for Outstanding Service, therefore be it
