Vacant and Boarded-up Apartments

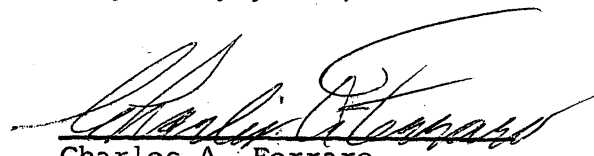
Gentlemen:
