SUBJECT: Council Order No. #2 (Dated - March 23, 1992)

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In response to Council Order Number 2, dated March 23, 1992,  
the following information is presented for your review:

1. As a result of a May 5, 1992 meeting with residents abutting St. Peter's Field, ten reflector shades have been installed on designated light standards in order to reduce glare. In addition, the Electrical Department re-directed a number of lights in order to alleviate the non-field illumination problems.
2. On May 19, 1992, a follow-up meeting was held with the residents at 225 Walden Street to review and assess the situation. At that meeting, residents expressed their appreciation with the lighting improvements undertaken by the City and felt the problem had been solved. A subsequent meeting with the Garden Street neighbors is scheduled for June 2, 1992.
