- WHEREAS: Primary elections will be held on September 16th; and
- WHEREAS: The City is under obligation to comply with making polling places accessible to the handicapped; and
- WHEREAS: Several of our polling places are not presently handicapped accessible; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council be furnished with a status report within two weeks, on the condition of the polling places in regard to handicapped accessibility and a time table as to when we can expect this to be accomplished, either for the primary or the general election; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That if polling places will not be fully accessible to the handicapped for the September primary that the Election Commission be requested to make a special effort through newspaper advertising etc. to make the handicapped whose polling places are not accessible, aware of the availability of absentee ballots.
