WHEREAS

Because of the absence of bath accommodations in many of the homes in the immediate vicinity of Cambridge Field the baths in the Shelter Building are almost indispensable to the health and happiness of the residents and

WHEREAS

The baths, because of their delapidated and unsanitary condition, are a positive menace and disgrace to the City of Cambridge, it is

ORDERED:-

That His Honor, the Mayor, be and hereby is requested to order the Board of Park Commissioners to close the baths at Cambridge Field or take the necessary steps to improve the unsanitary conditions that now exist therein, and also that they make necessary repairs to the lockers and shower baths in the basement of the Thorndike School.
