The Board of Election Commissioners wishes to confirm that arrangements had been made with regard to the Roosevelt Towers polling area for the September Primary Election and will be made again for the November General Election.

The Cambridge Housing Authority assured that the construction area has been fenced in since renovations began and poses no risk to persons walking in the area of the Back Building. Please note, the Back Building is fully occupied by residents who use the area on a daily basis.

Further arrangements have been made by the manager of Roosevelt Towers with the construction company to install lighting on the fence outside the building being renovated to illuminate the walkway from Windsor Street.

Prior to the Primary Election in September, the Commission became aware of the Roosevelt Towers renovation project. The area was visited by Commissioner Darleen Bonislowski and Chairperson of the Board of Election Commissioners Artis Spears, and special arrangements were made with Public Works for additional signage. As you know, torrential rains during the September Primary were a hindrance to continued posting of the signs throughout the day.

The DPW has prepared new signage for the polling location which will be posted on Tuesday, November 5th for the General Election.

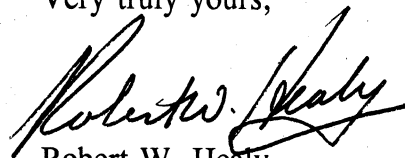
