Trombly Commuter Lines, Inc. ("Trombly" or "Petitioner"), a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and having its principal place of business in Dracut, Massachusetts, hereby petitions the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") pursuant to the provisions of G.L. c. 159A, s. 5 to issue a Temporary License authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the common carriage of passengers for hire over public ways in the following municipalities as more specifically set forth in Attachment A hereto: North Andover, Methuen, Lawrence, Andover, Tewksbury, North Reading, Wilmington, Woburn, Reading, Stoneham, Winchester, Medford, Somerville, Cambridge and Boston. In support of its Petition, the Petitioner respectfully represents as follows:

1. The Petitioner is in the transportation business.
2. The carrier presently providing commuter service between points in Boston and points in Andover, North Andover and Lawrence has notified passengers using this service and the Department of a schedule change pursuant to which the present carrier is dropping twelve daily trips from Monday to Friday. In addition, the current carrier is also eliminating all commuter service on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays which consisted of twenty-four runs. These changes are effective as of Sunday, January 29, 1989.
3. As a result of the change of schedule to be implemented by the present carrier there will be an interruption of existing transportation services on January 29, 1989.

4. In order to avoid any such interruption of existing service due to the change of schedule discussed in Paragraph 2 above, the Petitioner is prepared to provide commuter service between points in Boston and points in Lawrence, Andover and North Andover.
5. The Petitioner has been selected by the MBTA to operate service from North Andover to Boston pursuant to a Request for Proposal to provide passenger service.
6. In view of the need to commence service on January 30, 1989 in order to avoid an interruption of existing service, there is not sufficient time within which to obtain all the necessary municipal street licenses and a certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Department as required by the provisions of G.L. c 159A prior to January 30, 1989.
7. Petitioner will promptly apply for all necessary street licenses.
8. The motor vehicles used to provide the above described service will be operated over the routes set forth in Attachment A. The vehicles will be inspected and approved by the Department and will be operated by D.P.U. licensed drivers.

WHEREFORE, in order to avoid the interruption of existing transportation services and to meet an unusual and unforeseen transportation need, the Petitioner respectfully requests that the Department grant it a Temporary License to provide the requested service for a period of one hundred and twenty days.
