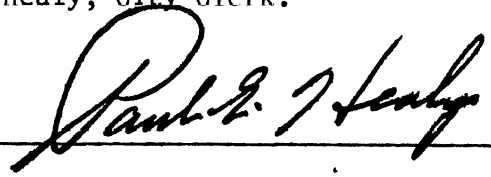
COUNCILLOR WALTER SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: Dr. Murthy's brilliant medical career was brought to an untimely and sudden end when he recently suffered a fatal heart attack, leaving a void among his family, friends and colleagues; now therefore be it
