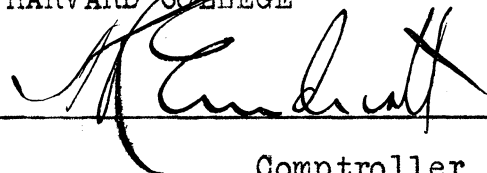

July 28, 1931

The cost of materials furnished to be assessed upon the owners of abutting estates according to law.

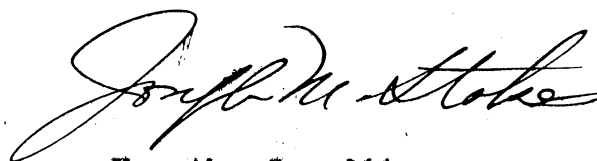
