WHEREAS: Pedestrian signs and crossing guards insure greater safety for children during school hours; and

WHEREAS: The intersection of Bishop Allen Drive and Columbia Street lack the crucial services of a crossing guard and adequate pedestrian signs, posing a danger to pedestrians in general and to school children in particular; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Council hereby request that the City Manager provide a crossing guard at the intersection of Columbia Street and Bishop Allen Drive, and further provide all necessary and appropriate pedestrian signs.
