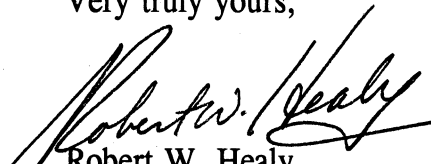
To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 19, regarding a report on the condition of the fountain and courtyard area and lighting of the Manning Apartments and Central Square Library, please be advised of the following:

The Superintendent of Streets and Sidewalks has inspected the condition of the fountain at the above mentioned location. The brick veneer is beyond repair and the structure is showing signs of failure. It has been many years since the fountain has been in proper working order. The Superintendent recommends removal of the fountain is early Spring. In addition, the City's Landscape Architect is evaluating this site and will make recommendations for future improvements.

City Electrician George Fernandes reports that lighting in the area of the courtyard and along the walkway adjacent to the parking garage facing Manning Apartment will be improved within the next six months. A contract is in place to improve and/or replace all lighting in and outside the parking garage.
