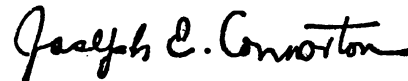

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached are two appropriation orders for \$35,000 each for tourism and development under contracts with the Chamber of Commerce and Cambridge Discovery. The source of funding is from the hotel/motel tax.

As the City Council may recall, during the debate relative to the acceptance of this local option tax measure, meetings were held with the principals of the local hotels. A commitment was made at that time to expend a small percentage of this new revenue for tourism. The most appropriate mechanism to achieve this purpose was agreed to be contracts with these two agencies. This appropriation represents the third year of this funding.
