To the Honorable, the City Council:

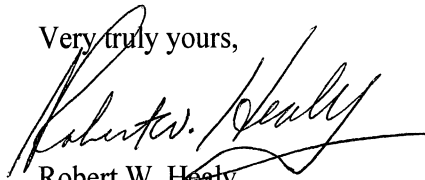
In response to Awaiting Report Item Number 03-130, regarding a report on any areas that have had signs posted changing residential parking to two-hour maximum parking, please be advised of the following:

Parking changes were made by the Traffic, Parking & Transportation Department following discussions with the Cambridge Street reconstruction project manager in response to requests from Cambridge Street businesses to relieve parking lost during the reconstruction project.

Based on this request, the Department posted temporary 2-hour parking restrictions on side streets off of Cambridge Street from Columbia Street to First Street. These restrictions affect a total of six streets that, before these changes were made, had unrestricted parking.

The current restrictions will be in effect until July 2004.
