Adopted by the affirmative vote of nine members.

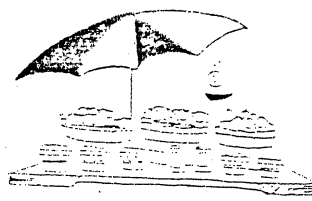

We hope that you will find this acceptable. We will be in touch with you next week concerning this and any other questions which might arise.

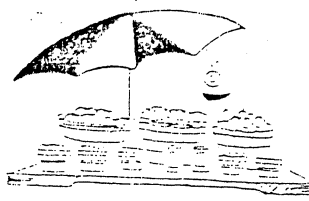
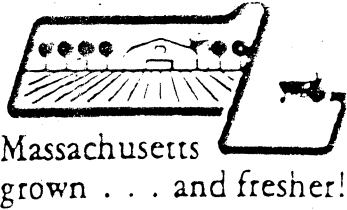
