On December 8, 1931, Councillor Joseph L. Crowley introduced an order transferring land known as Cofran's Pit and bounded by Vassal Lane and Fresh Pond Avenue to the jurisdiction of the Board of Park Commissioners to be established as a playground. Said order was approved by His Honor the Mayor on December 10, 1931.
