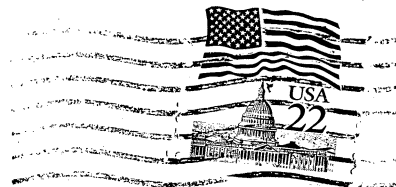

Please transmit the enclosed to the City Council as expression of my continued pleasure with service from the Cambridge Police Department. Please also transmit my apologies for the typing. It was originally delivered to the department at approximately 7:15 A.M.

At the same, please express to the Council my pleasure at last night's vote on Central Square, interpreting the order as did Councillor David Sullivan, as, in no way approving zoning and development objectives.

I further interpret last night's vote as neutral on the reports in appendix III which gives the impression of reporting all land uses from City Hall to Hancock Street. This appendix, as I stated Monday night, is misleading to the extent of being false. It reports every single office resident in the area and occasionally lumps vast amounts of housing as "residential" while blatantly ignoring other major housing (i.e. 891 Mass, apparently listing the entire building as occupied by an apparently illegal (under Rent Control) broker's office, inasmuch as absolutely nothing else is listed).

The City Hall - Hancock St. portion of this appendix does not even have the saving grace, as in the balance of the appendix III, of stating numbers of residential units on the separate map entitled "Rent Controlled Residential Units" in Appendix VIII (Apparently because rent controlled housing is more difficult to destroy).

The clear impact of the combination of omissions is to give a false impression of these blocks, blocks which should not have been in the report in the first place. That false impression comports with years of Development Departments attempts at destruction of maximum numbers of existing housing units on Massachusetts Avenue, particularly first floor housing. We are all aware of the many times the City Council has rejected those attempts, and of the disreputable actions with regard to 871/875 Massachusetts Avenue.

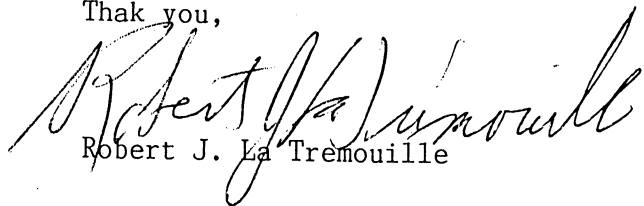
DEar Chief:
