WHEREAS: This is a program in Soweto that uses music—strings—to provide youth with opportunities in artistic and other life pursuits. The group has been featured on 60 Minutes and is currently on a global tour to raise funds for the program; and

WHEREAS: The BSSP was established in Britain by a viola player Rosemary Nalden in 1997. It currently has approximately 70 students ranging from age five to twenty-four, all of whom are drawn from the local community of Diepkloof, Soweta, in South Africa; and

WHEREAS: The BSSP gives the opportunity to children with impoverished backgrounds to learn classical stringed instruments to the highest possible standards; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record encouraging all Cantabrigians to participate in the fundraiser effort for a very noble cause; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is request to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Buskaid Soweto String Project and St Paul's Church on behalf of the entire City Council.
