WHEREAS: Every weekday, neighborhood residents and area commuters passing through the intersection of Linnaean Street and Massachusetts Avenue stop to smile at the smiles of the children leaving George McEachern's office trailing their helium filled balloons on strings and stopping to look down at their fingers to admire the rings awarded by Mr. McEachern to all the good and brave children who pass through his office, and

WHEREAS: A "McEachern Smile" has become a not-so-well-kept Cambridge secret trademark, for the many children who cheerfully and not so cheerfully endured years of rubber bands and head gear to emerge with beautiful, winning, smiles; now therefore be it
