(Order to Construct Sidewalks - General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, Chapter 83.)

IN CITY COUNCIL
April 25, 1977

WHEREAS:

In the judgement of this City Council public convenience requires that granolithic sidewalks should be established, graded and constructed and existing sidewalks reconstructed, as hereinafter stated, and it is therefore

ORDERED:

That granolithic sidewalks be established, graded and constructed, and existing sidewalks reconstructed, including edgestones where necessary, as hereinafter stated, to wit, in front of premises

No. 32 Highland Street, Supposed owner William S. Edgerly,
Assessor's Block Plan 223, Lot No. 1.

No. 27 Irving Street, Supposed owner Unihab/Renovate, Inc.,
Assessor's Block Plan 142, Lot No. 118.

The aforesaid plans are on file in the Assessors' Office, City Hall, Cambridge, Mass.

The grade of said sidewalks is to conform, substantially, to the grade of the street, and all matters not herein particularly specified in regard to the construction of said sidewalks are to be determined by the Commissioner of Public Works, subject to the approval and under the direction of the City Manager.

And the said Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and instructed to grade, construct and reconstruct said sidewalks and in the manner aforesaid, and to report to this City Council, after the completion of the work, the cost thereof, and the assessment of one-half the cost shall be made upon the abutting estates.

A copy of this order, certified by the City Clerk, shall be recorded forthwith in the Middlesex South District Registry of Deeds.

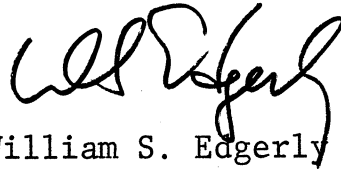
