IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED:

On the petition of Drayton Hall Trust, B. M. Moskow, Trustee, of 68 Devonshire Street, Boston, the Commissioner of Public Works be authorized under the provisions of the City Ordinances to grant a permit or license to said Drayton Hall Trust to construct and maintain a steel fire escape consisting of three egress balconies extending over the sidewalk at the premises numbered 48 Boylston Street, said fire escape and balconies weighing approximately 900 pounds.

Provided that, before erecting the above named fire escape the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said fire escape and balconies.
