MAYOR WOLF

WHEREAS: The state budget includes a substantial reduction in funding for the State Housing Voucher Program; and

WHEREAS: These cuts reduce each tenant's subsidy by \$200 per month, thus raising each tenant's share of the rent by \$200; and

WHEREAS: For some tenants, the \$200 will be an impossible burden to bear; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to work with the appropriate housing agencies to provide the eight families in Cambridge who will be affected by this cut with referrals to make sure they are able to take advantage of whatever resources are available.
