WHEREAS: In this year's budget the City Council also approved the hiring of twenty-two civilians in the Police Department to free up thirteen officers for active duty, and to date those positions have not been filled; and

WHEREAS: The City Council is interested in seeing these positions filled at the earliest possible date to ensure the maximum number of officers on the street, but also in its fiduciary role, the City Council would like to have for its information the amount of savings that have accrued during this five month period; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report to the City Council as to the amount of projected savings during this time period, and how it will be utilized.
