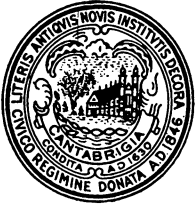


Dear Mr. Sullivan:

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$177.36 to reimburse James Curtin, employee of the Public Works Department, for damages in this amount.

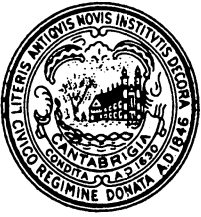
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against James Curtin in which there was a judgment of \$177.36.
