Gentlemen:

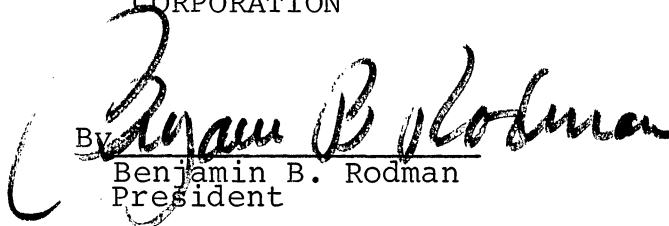
In connection with the proposed Amendment to the Cambridge Zoning Ordinance submitted by Rosemarie Quinton et al dated March 23, 1981, and entitled Cambridgeport Area Rezoning Petition, please be advised that I wish to record our opposition to the zoning change. I have read the objection signed by eleven property owners submitted to your Council on April 15, 1981 and I incorporate by reference their objections and join in support of their position.

More specifically, the intended redrawing of the zoning lines has a significant adverse impact upon the property owned by Blake Henry Realty Corporation, 38 Henry Street, Cambridge, which can only result in the loss of several hundred jobs as well as a diminution in real estate taxes.

Finally, I would appreciate the opportunity to make my views known before your honorable body.
