Subject MOVING GREEN STREET HYDRANT

Dear Sir:

In accordance with your request I wish to advise you as to the Council Order of May 25, 1953, relative to the moving of the hydrant on Green Street near the Municipal Parking Lot.

This hydrant is serviced from the 20-inch main in Green Street and is not independently gated, which means that it will be necessary to close the main and connecting gates on this main between Pleasant and Sidney Streets. I do not recommend that the hydrant be moved to the back of the sidewalk because in my opinion it would just force foot traffic to the edge of the roadway. In view of the fact that this street carries heavy traffic, a large portion of which is heavy trucking, serious injury to pedestrians might develop.

If in your opinion it should be moved, it is my recommendation that the hydrant be placed within the parking lot with suitable fencing to protect it from parked cars and still make it available for use by the Fire Department. If the hydrant is to be moved, a controlling gate will be installed. This would be an additional reason for the suggested location, as it will be necessary to make the installation of the gate unless the Green Street road bed is to be torn up.

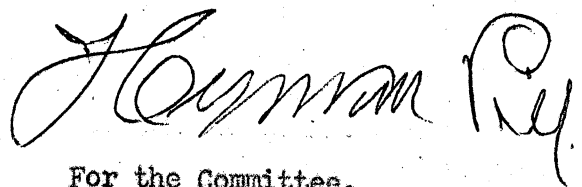
