He went on to serve in the Pacific Theatre as a Captain in the US Army and then joined the OB/GYN staff of Mt. Auburn Hospital, St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Brighton and Cambridge City Hospital from 1947 until his retirement in 1982.

Hester was a member of the Massachusetts Medical Association.

There will be a funeral Mass at St. Peter's Church on Dec. 30 followed by interment at St. John's Cemetery in Lancaster.
