The City Council in 1935 dedicated this location to the late Captain Donahue in honor of his devotion as a police officer and his expertise in traffic circulation, and

WHEREAS:

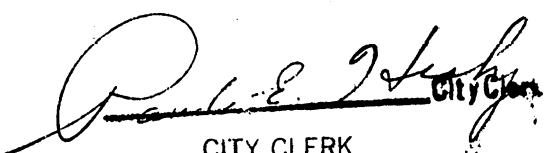
