An offer has been received by the City Council for the purchase of City owned land situated on Cedar Street, it is

ORDERED:

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is authorized, in the name of and in behalf of the City of Cambridge, to sell and convey to Charles T. Cavanagh for the sum of One Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$1,300) a parcel of land situated and described as follows:-

Westerly by Cedar Street 59.28 feet, northwesterly by land now or formerly of Frank Yanulevicius 89.38 feet, northeasterly by land now or formerly of Mary J. Ferreria 40.50 feet, southeasterly and northeasterly by land now or formerly of John G. Russo et al 50 feet and 6 feet respectively, and southeasterly by land now or formerly of John F. Murphy 76.55 feet. Said parcel is Lot No. 78 on Assessors' Block Plan No. 191 and contains 4,720 square feet of land more or less.
