

City of Cambridge.

In the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one.

An Ordinance,
relating to the laying out and acceptance of Streets.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:-

1. All streets, hereafter laid out, which
shall be two hundred feet or more in length,
shall be not less than forty feet wide; and all
streets, not two hundred feet in length, shall be
not less than thirty feet wide.

2. No street shall hereafter be accepted,
unless it be of the width required in this Ordinance.

3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances,
inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby
repealed.
