The survey work for the drainage problems at the lower end of Huron Avenue has been done by the Consulting Engineers, CE Maguire, as part of the overall sewer status for the City. The construction of the work in this area has recently been approved by the State and the Environmental Protection Agency. Contracts for this work will be advertised for bids within the next sixty-days, with construction to start early next spring. This construction should alleviate the drainage problems in this area.

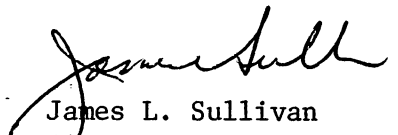
