- WHEREAS: A fire has destroyed the premises at 73-75-77 River Street; and
- WHEREAS: There are serious safety concerns raised by the current condition of the building, including attempted break-ins, glass panes on the street, and general debris; and
- WHEREAS: The owner of the building is responsible for the demolition of the top two floors and the time has expired for this action on his part; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the Council within two weeks time with regard to the time frame for demolishing the top two floors; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the report include information regarding the Rent Control status of the units of the building; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the area surrounding the building be cleaned so that dangerous materials such as glass be removed from that surrounding area and that posted city signs be checked so that they remain standing.
