

IN COMMITTEE OF CONFERENCE WITH CAMBRIDGE
ON NEW BRIDGE.

NOVEMBER 14, 1883.

VOTED,

THAT THE CITY ENGINEER OF BOSTON IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CITY ENGINEER OF CAMBRIDGE BE REQUESTED TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT TO THE COMMITTEE PRELIMINARY PLANS AND ESTIMATES OF THE COST OF THE PROPOSED NEW BRIDGE BETWEEN BOSTON AND CAMBRIDGE; THE EXPENSE ATTENDING THE MAKING OF SAID PLANS AND ESTIMATES NOT TO EXCEED TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS, TO BE PAID ONE-HALF BY THE CITY OF BOSTON AND ONE-HALF BY THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.
