That a hearing has been granted to the various abutments encroaching upon the line ^{of the street} as laid out upon the plan on file in office of the City Engineer, and the premises have been viewed; but your Committee received no definite and adequate evidence of any rightful claim of any of said parties ~~or~~ to ownership of the land upon which they have been deemed to encroach, And as it is, therefore not a matter of widening of said street, but rather the removal of encroachments upon the true line of the street, ~~your committee~~ the papers are returned with the recommendation that they be refer^d to the Com. on Roads & Bridges on the part of the B^d of Aldermen, For the Committee,
