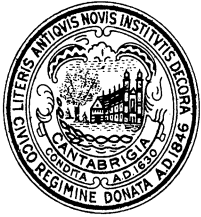
I would recommend increasing these two lights from 1000 lumens to 2500 lumens.




