MAYOR VELLUCCI

- WHEREAS: The longest war in Africa has devastated the lives of more than two million innocent Eritrean Civilians; and
- WHEREAS: For over the past five years, repeated droughts and the desert locust have increased their suffering. Despite the generous efforts of humanitarian relief agencies working at an international level, many thousands of Eritrean Children have died in the past three year; and
- WHEREAS: The Eritrean Relief Committee is a tax exempt humanitarian organization whose mission is to raise funds to support the food relief, medical care reconstruction programs and education for the largest percentage of the Eritrean population who do not receive such aid from these international humanitarian organizations; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, encourage the citizens of Cambridge to join with the Eritrean Relief Committee "in an Eritrean Evening" on December 10, 1988 at Memorial Hall, Harvard University in which will include a dinner and dancing, photo exhibits and formal presentations by Eritreans and the Eritrean Cultural troupes.
