- WHEREAS: Dick was hired July 31, 1972 as Chief Planner; and
- WHEREAS: Dick played a key role in the planning for major transportation infrastructure projects such as the Red Line Extension to Alewife, including the Linear Path, the East Cambridge Riverfront Plan, North Point Roadways, Massachusetts Avenue/Lafayette Square upgrade and the future Urban Ring project; and
- WHEREAS: Dick served for more than twenty-five years as the city's representative to multiple regional planning agencies such as the Metropolitan Area Planning Council the MBTA Advisory Board and the Joint Regional Transportation Committee; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record expressing its appreciation to Richard Easler for thirty years of dedicated service to the City of Cambridge; and wishing him a happy and healthy retirement; and be it further
