COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

June 15, 1981

- WHEREAS: New development for industrial, commercial and office uses and improvements of conservation resources are made possible by Alewife rezoning ordinance adopted by the Cambridge City Council; and
- WHEREAS: Sound development of the Alewife area can bring benefits of increased employment, increased tax base, improved transportation and access to work, services and recreation to Cambridge citizens; and
- WHEREAS: The scope of potential development and changes at Alewife, encompassing 370 acres, is unusually large for a city of relatively small size such as Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Five separate neighborhoods abut the Alewife development area and no presently organized neighborhood group could appropriately represent the interests of all neighborhoods affected or the city as a whole; and
- WHEREAS: A working committee of dedicated citizens representing neighborhood as well as citywide concerns could contribute greatly by devoting time to understanding all aspects of the proposed development in the interests of Cambridge as a whole; to be a sounding board for helping to evaluate alternative plans; to anticipate problems so as to avoid misunderstandings and disharmony; to help avoid development which clashes with neighborhood, or city life; to inform fellow citizens and neighborhood groups of progress and issues relating to Alewife; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager designate and appoint an Alewife Advisory Committee, including citizens from abutting neighborhoods; representatives of citywide groups and interests; conservation and recreation, labor and business interests; and such other representation as he deems advisable; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That such Alewife Advisory Committee shall be a working committee whose members shall be expected to meet regularly to monitor and assess impacts of development on neighborhoods and the City; to inform themselves of progress in the area and of plans for building, for federal or state funding proposals, and of any other aspects of Alewife development relating to the well-being of the people of Cambridge. Part-time administrative assistance in conducting their committee business shall be provided by the Community Development Department. Members shall serve without compensation.
