

City of Cambridge,

In the year One Thousand
Eight Hundred and Eighty Eight,

An Ordinance
in amendment of an Ordinance in
Relation to Sheets.

Be it ordained by the City
Council of the City of Cambridge as
follows:

1 Chapter 36, of the Revised Ordinances
2 is hereby amended by adding at the end of
3 Section 16, as amended Dec 30. 1885, the following
4 paragraph:—

5 " Whenever the Superintendent of Streets,
6 is about to construct a new sheet, or to break
7 up the surface of any public way, he shall, at
8 least two weeks before beginning work, notify the
9 City Engineer as head of the Sewer department,
10 the Superintendent of Lamps and the Water Board.

11 If either of these departments has any work
12 to be done in the sheet ^{or way} so designated, it shall
13 consult and arrange with the Superintendent of
14 Streets, in order that such work may be done
15 before the surface of such street or way is again
16 prepared for, and opened to public travel. after
17 such notice and opportunity have been given

18 neither of the three departments of sewers, lamps or
19 water, shall, for the space of six months, break
20 up such street or way within the area of such
21 persons disturbance, except in case of obvious
22 necessity to be certified to and approved by the
23 Mayor. No street or public way shall be
24 opened by drain-layers or others, between the
25 fifteenth day of November, and the first day
26 of April, except in cases of necessity certified
27 to and approved by the Mayor as herein before
28 provided.
