- WHEREAS:** John first joined the Revenue Department as a Tax Examiner in 1951 and rose to positions of varying responsibility during his thirty-one years of service, being appointed Deputy Commissioner of the Department in 1979; and
- WHEREAS:** John was active in North Andover politics where he has lived for many years, serving as a member of the Board of Selectmen from 1973 to 1979 and prior to this service also served as a member of the Town's Personnel Board; and
- WHEREAS:** John was not only a dedicated public employee, but one who was always willing to listen to a problem whether it was from a family member, friend or business associate, a man who truly was filled with compassion for people; now therefore be it

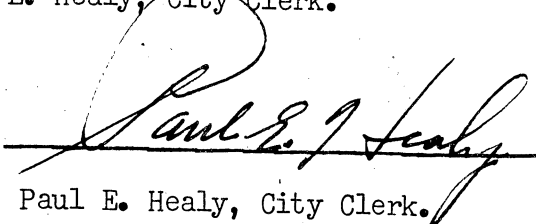
