COUNCILLOR WYLIE

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct all appropriate departments to refrain from issuing any permits or licenses to either the MBTA or the construction company named Morrison-Knudsen for a third shift work schedule until such time as the damage claim of Thomas Murray, owner of Small World of Books is satisfactorily resolved; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Assistant City Manager for Administration to investigate the possibility of other pending claims and to withhold all permits for a third shift until said claims are resolved.
