IN CITY COUNCIL

September 30, 1974

ORDERED:

On the petition of the Sage Building, that the Commissioner of Public Works be authorized under the provisions of the City Ordinances to grant a permit or license to said Sage Building to construct and maintain a metal fire escape extending over the sidewalk at the premises numbered 66 Church Street, Cambridge, said fire escape weighing approximately 1,000 pounds.

Provided that, before erecting the above named fire escape the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said fire escape.
