WHEREAS: The 1992 International Fair will be highlighted by a FESTA ITALIANA and a CARNAVALE CARIBENO in honor of the Columbian Quincentennial; and

WHEREAS: The International Fair will feature such international performers as Humano, Batwel Rada, Diversity, and Inca Son, in addition to many roving performers, storytellers, magicians, and musicians; and

WHEREAS: Representatives of the Tsukuba Sister City Committee, the Dante Alighieri Society, and other Cambridge cultural organizations will be participating in the International Fair through performances, foods, and crafts; and

WHEREAS: The International Fair expresses the rich variety of ethnic cultures in Cambridge and provides performances to reach people of all age and backgrounds; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That I, Kenneth E. Reeves, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, and the Cambridge City Council do hereby proclaim June 13, 1992 International Day in Cambridge; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council does hereby congratulate the Arts Council for producing the second Cambridge International Fair; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be instructed to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Arts Council on June 13, 1992.
