AN ORDINANCE

Establishing Salaries of members of the Police Department

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

The salaries for members of the Police Department are hereby fixed and established as follows, to wit:-

Captains of Police.....	\$1650
Lieutenants of Police.....	1500
Sergeants of Police.....	1400
Patrolmen.....	1300
Reserve Police Officers - 1st 12 mos. service	1000
Reserve Police Officers - 2nd 12 mos. service	1100
Reserve Police Officers - 3rd 12 mos. service	1200
Reserve Police Officers - 4th 12 mos. service	1300

This ordinance to take effect upon its passage and continue in effect until April 1, 1918, at which time the salaries for members of the Police Department shall be fixed and established as follows, to wit:-

Captains of Police.....	\$1800
Lieutenants of Police.....	1650
Sergeants of Police.....	1500
Patrolmen.....	1400
Reserve Police Officers - 1st 12 mos. service	1000
Reserve Police Officers - 2nd 12 mos. service	1100
Reserve Police Officers - 3rd 12 mos. service	1200
Reserve Police Officers - 4th 12 mos. service	1300
Reserve Police Officers - 5th 12 mos. service	1400

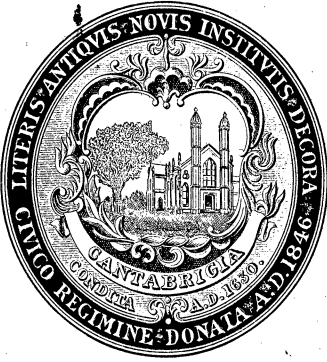

Gentlemen:

I am submitting herewith an appropriation for the Police Department as per attached Schedule A amounting to \$224,970.04 which includes the special appropriation authorized by the City Council on June 12, 1917 for \$17,798.48 and which is to be a part of the annual appropriation for the current fiscal year.

This estimate includes an amount necessary for salaries and payrolls from April to June 30 inclusive at the rates in force on April 1, 1917.

The appropriation from July 1, 1917 to March 31, 1918 inclusive provides for the increased pay in accordance with the
