In Board of Aldermen, Sept. 14. 1870.

Whereas it is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Concord Avenue should be widened on the Northern side, between Garden Street and Wyeth Street;

Ordered, That said Concord Avenue be widened on the Northern side, between the points above mentioned, by taking for this purpose so much land belonging to the abutters on the Northern side of said Concord Avenue as lies Southward of the new line delineated on a certain Plan of Concord Avenue, drawn by J. G. Chase, City Engineer, dated July 26, 1870, and now before this Board, and laying out the same as a public street or way and a part of said Concord Avenue.

Ordered, That damages for the land so taken be estimated and awarded as follows:
