ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to order the License Commission and the Law Department to prepare immediately and without delay home rule legislation for the city council's consideration which would restore to the Cambridge License Commission the legal power to determine the capacity of all licensed establishments. Recent state legislation has made the on premises licensed capacity equal to the number fixed by the Inspectional Services Department; needless to say, this latter determination does not take into account noise, disruption, suitability to the neighborhood, past behavior, etc.
