- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Charles H. Sullivan, a Cambridge native and late Foreman of the Cambridge Water Department; and
- WHEREAS: Charles spent many years as a resident, attending local schools, graduating from the former Rindge Technical High School, prior to serving his country as a member of the United States Navy during World War II; and
- WHEREAS: Charles has been associated with and active in veteran's affairs for the past thirty-two years and was a Past Commander of the North Cambridge Post 7353, Veterans of Foreign Wars and served at one time as the National V.F.W. Inspector General and at the time of his death was President of the Massachusetts V.F.W. Convention Corporation; and
- WHEREAS: Charles was a dedicated public employee, assigned to the Water Department, where he held several positions of varying responsibility during his thirty-seven year career; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Susan Sullivan and to the entire Sullivan family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Sullivan on behalf of the entire City Council.
