The Committee on Roads and Bridges
to which was referred the petition of Andrew Sprunt
and others, praying for the acceptance of Wright Street
so-called,

Reports

That your committee has
heard the petitioners, and has visited the street
above named. Wright street is a private way
about twenty feet wide, extending from Hudson
street northerly to Norton street, so-called, - also a
private way. In the opinion of your committee
~~the~~ said Wright street should be widened at
least five feet on each side, before being accepted
by the city. There is ample room for such
widening ~~on each side of the street~~, but many
of the abutters are not willing to give the land
for the purpose, and your committee does not
believe that the public necessity requires that the
city should take the land and pay for it. It is
recommended that the petitioners have leave to
withdraw.

To the Honorable, the City Council,
of the City of Cambridge,

The undersigned respectfully ~~pray~~ represent that Wright Street, so-called, the same being an unaccepted street, ^{has been} open for public use for about fifty years, and petitions have been filed from time to time with the City Council, asking for the acceptance of said street. The matter of such acceptance has been deferred on the ground that the street was not of the width required by the City Ordinance.

Inasmuch as the ordinance especially provide for ~~cases~~ where streets have been open for a long period, the undersigned believe that this street can be laid out without conflicting with any existing ordinance.

Wherefore Your petitioners respectfully pray that said Wright Street may be accepted and laid out as a public way.
