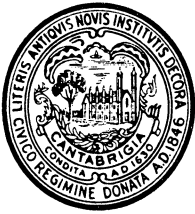
Subject City Council Order #9 of March 19, 1984 "Mt. Auburn St. Traffic Pattern

The City of Cambridge has completed a study of Mt. Auburn Street from Coolidge Hill Road to the Belmont and Watertown town lines and are now in the process of designing new intersections and roadways for this area within the existing right-of-way. This work being done in cooperation with the Public Works Department includes new channelization, the raising of the curbing and complete roadway construction. This will be done under our 1984 Chapter 90 Program.

I can see only one problem in this process and that is getting the towns of Belmont and Watertown to agree on the intersection design of Mt. Auburn Street, Belmont Street and Holworthy Street. We are meeting with them and we are sure we can come up with a plan that is satisfactory to all parties.
