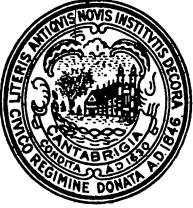

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$280.43 to reimburse Robert Flynn, employee of the Cambridge Police Department, for damages in this amount.

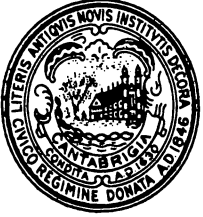
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Robert Flynn, in which there was a judgment of \$280.43.
