- WHEREAS: They wanted to continue on with their religious activities, so they met under the leadership of Mr. John S. Brown at the home of Ms. Grace Manuel on Windsor Street in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Under the leadership of the first minister, the Reverend Kenneth DeP Hughs, they acquired the Methodist Church on Harvard street in the 1940s; and
- WHEREAS: This church became St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church; and
- WHEREAS: Over the years, the pastor and the Church have continued to be an important influence in the religious community and the broader community; and
- WHEREAS: Under the leadership of Reverend Nelson Foxx, the Church is continuing to honor this legacy of its founders; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record congratulating St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church on the occasion of its 100th Anniversary; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record expressing its best wishes to St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church as they celebrate their 100th Anniversary with an evening of inspirational music and liturgical dance on Saturday, March 29, 2008; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church on behalf of the entire City Council.
